Factory stains and finishes are applied under optimum conditions in a controlled environment by trained finishing experts.










Natural Veneer Variations



Characteristics

Natural veneers, even within the same species, may vary significantly in color and grain pattern. Biology and environment play an important role in determining the variability and beauty in wood. While these natural characteristics can be subtle in unfinished veneers, they may be accentuated by the application of a clear finish. Many designers and architects seek this natural color variation, while others prefer a more uniform look.

Attaining a more uniform appearance in veneers — such as maple, birch and ash — can be achieved, in part, by the use of stain

color and/or selecting the proper veneer by color. Stain color can be used to enhance the natural beauty of the veneer, or mute natural color variations and grain patterns. In general, lighter stain colors make the grain pattern more pronounced, while darker colors usually conceal more of the grain variations. Specifying a “select” veneer that is inspected, sorted for color and pattern matched will help in achieving your desired look.

Consult your distributor, designer, architect or Oshkosh Door Company for assistance in color or veneer selection.

Our veneer and finish standards comply with WDMA and AWI guidelines.



Field Finishing

Specifying factory finishing is the sole way to ensure the desired look is achieved in an environmentally-friendly manner. Responsibility for final preparation, application and appearance of the finish is assumed by those who apply it.

The Oshkosh Door Company warranty does not cover the appearance of field finished doors, nor damage or effect caused by failing to comply with proper field finishing preparation or techniques.
